HOW CAN CaIVCB HELP?

The California Victim Compensation Board (CaIVCB) provides financial assistance to crime victims. Help is available for victims, family members, and loved ones who are injured or threatened with injury as a result of a crime. CaIVCB CAN HELP PAY FOR:

- Counseling
- Medical and dental treatment and equipment
- Income loss
- Funeral and burial expenses
- Residential security
- Home or vehicle modifications for victims who become disabled
- Crime-scene clean up
- Relocation
- Service Dogs
