**Victim compensation is a lifelong benefit for victims of violent crime. CaIVCB is here to help.**

## How can CaIVCB help me?

- Victims who suffer physical injury or emotional injury due to the threat of physical injury may qualify for assistance.
- CaIVCB helps you pay for expenses related to a violent crime that aren't covered by any other source.
- Once approved for assistance, victims are eligible for up to \$70,000 in lifetime compensation. Limits apply to some services.

## Who is eligible?

CaIVCB can help victims and their families when the crime happens in California, or when a crime happens to a California resident in another state or country. United States citizenship is not required to apply for financial help.

Victims can submit an application within seven years of the crime, or when the crime could have been discovered, or up to seven years after a child victim turns 21 years old.
