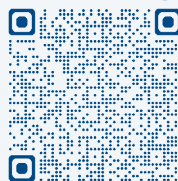

**Deaf and hard of hearing:
Call the California Relay Service at 711*

Those impacted by the shooting at the Islamic Center of San Diego are encouraged to apply to the California Victim Compensation Board (CaIVCB). This program can help pay for crime-related bills not covered by other sources.

You may qualify for up to \$70,000 in compensation if you are any of the following:

- **Physically** injured or **emotionally** injured due to the threat of physical injury
- **A family member, roommate, or caretaker** of those injured or killed
- **A witness** to the crime

Victims have seven years from the date of the incident to apply. The application must be filed by May 18, 2033.

**Those under 21 have until their 28th birthday.*

Crowdfunding

GoFundMe money is not in conflict with CaIVCB payments. You can receive both. But you cannot get CaIVCB payment for expenses already paid by GoFundMe or any other source.
